



## FACILITY AND CONDUCT RULES FOR WESTMINSTER LITTLE LEAGUE

1. **Any decision by an umpire, which involves judgment, such as, but not limited to, whether a batted ball is fair or foul, whether a pitch is a strike or a ball or whether a runner is safe or out, is final.** No manager, coach, player or spectator shall object to any such judgment decisions. Each Umpire has the authority to rule on any point not specifically covered in the Little League Rulebook.
2. Once a game is in progress, the umpire has the final decision regarding stoppage of the game due to poor lighting, darkness, inclement weather, etc. The exception to this is one or more of the Board of Directors shall determine if a game stoppage is necessary for same reasons at Tepper Fields.
3. A player ejected from a game **MUST** leave the premises, provided she/he has their parent there to take them home. This includes all fields, walkways and parking lots. If a player is ejected from two or more games, a review by the Westminster Little League Board of Directors will determine whether or not the player will be allowed to return to the Westminster Little League facilities.
4. A District or Board Member may not make any decision, which affects a game in which their child is a participant. Exception: If said Board Member is the only authorized person available, that Board Member shall have the authority to make a ruling.
5. For everyone safety, absolutely **NO SKATEBOARDING, ROLLERBLADING, BICYCLE OR SCOOTER RIDING** is allowed at the Little League complex at 73<sup>rd</sup> & Depew. For the safety of all players, coaches and spectators, **NO PETS ARE ALLOWED.**
6. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR DRUGS** are allowed on the premises of any authorized Little League facility, including City owned facilities and School District facilities. Smoking at the Westminster Little League complex on 73<sup>rd</sup> & Depew is allowed at the designated smoking areas. **No smoking around the bleachers or dugouts.**
7. Any physical or verbal abuse toward umpires, players, coaches or spectators will not be tolerated at any time. Violation of this rule will result in removal from the facility.
8. Improper conduct by a spectator, manager or coach may result in that person or persons being removed from the premises. The Westminster Little League Board of Directors will determine whether or not the individual will be allowed to return to the League facility.
9. Before leaving the field, please ensure that the area where you have been watching practices or games has been picked up and trash disposed of in closest trash bin.
10. Your cooperation on all points outlined here will be greatly appreciated.

Westminster Little League believes that safety of all people, include players, coaches, umpires and spectators are of the utmost importance. To this end, the following **Rules of Conduct** will be strictly enforced at all Westminster Little League games and facilities.

1. Physical assaults, fights or violence will not be tolerated at any time.
2. Weapons of any kind are prohibited at the playing fields.

**The police will be called to respond to complaints and violators will be prosecuted!!**
