Rules and Regulations

The use of Tepper Fields is limited to the practice, playing and observing of games sanctioned by Westminster Little League, Colorado District 2 and Little League Baseball. Any other use of this facility without the express, written, consent of Westminster Little League is strictly prohibited.

Westminster Little League is committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable ballpark experience. Our staff will proactively intervene to ensure the following:

NO

- Bicycle or Scooter Riding
- Skateboarding or Rollerblading
- Tree Climbing
- Fence Climbing
- Rock Throwing
- Wall Ball
- Pick-up games or play of any kind on vacant fields
- Unsupervised children
- Animals (except certified dogs for Guests with Disabilities)
- Alcoholic Beverages or illegal drugs
- Obscene or indecent clothing
- Foul or abusive language
- Interruption of game progress by a Guest
- Fireworks, firearms or other weapons
- Activity deemed unsafe by the Westminster Little League Board of Directors

If a Guest is found to be in violation of these safety regulations, they will be removed from the ballpark and subject to arrest.

Guests assume all risks and danger incidental to the game of baseball, whether occurring prior to, during or subsequent to the actual playing of the game; including without limitation, injury from thrown bats, thrown or batted balls and spectator conduct. Westminster Little League cannot be held responsible for the conduct of other Guests when attempting to obtain a foul or homerun ball. Guests agree that neither Westminster Little League nor the opposing team, their respective players and agents shall be liable for injuries or damages caused by such risks or dangers.
